HIGH 5	<ul> <li>An excellent range of passing/dribbling skills to create openings.</li> <li>Shows precision, control &amp; fluency when applying different skills.</li> <li>An ability to use different methods to score (set, jump and layup).</li> <li>Understands how the body reacts during the warm-up &amp; cool down.</li> </ul>
6	<ul> <li>Demonstrates a high level of attacking and tactical awareness.</li> <li>Able to plan, perform and evaluate their performance and others.</li> <li>Demonstrates numerous ways to improve performance during match play.</li> </ul>
7	<ul> <li>Pupils demonstrate an advanced level of passing, dribbling and shooting.</li> <li>Pupils apply skills with precision and originality.</li> <li>Advanced application of attacking (screening) and defending (Press) skills.</li> </ul>
Exceptional Performance	<ul> <li>Pupils consistently use advanced skills, techniques and ideas.</li> <li>Skills used with precision, originality, flair, control and fluency.</li> <li>Reach judgements independently about their own and others' performance.</li> </ul>
